

1. Effectiveness of delivery of lectures by the faculty

83 responses




Out of 95 respondents, 83 students give their responses regarding effectiveness of delivery of lectures by the faculty.

From the responses of 83 students, it shows that 42.2% responses from 83 respondents are highly satisfied followed by 38.6% are satisfied with the effectiveness of delivery of lectures by the faculty. But 18.1% responses are average and the remaining 1.1% respondents are providing dissatisfactory responses.

So, from of this survey question, it is become clear that students are satisfied with the effectiveness of the lectures delivered by the teachers, but need to improve.

2. Completion of course in time

86 responses




Out of 95 respondents, 86 students give their responses regarding completion of course in time.

From the responses of 86 students, it shows that 41.9% responses from 86 respondents are satisfied followed by 34.9% are highly satisfied with the completion of course in time. But 18.6% responses are average and the remaining 4.6% respondents are providing dissatisfactory responses.

So, from of this survey question, it is become clear that students are not fully satisfied with completion of course in time by the teachers. Hence, teachers are given more emphasis for the completion the course in due course of time.

3. Coverage of syllabus in class

85 responses




Out of 95 respondents, 85 students give their responses regarding the coverage of syllabus in class.

From the responses of 85 students, it shows that 37.6% responses from 85 respondents are satisfied followed by 35.3% are highly satisfied with the coverage of syllabus in class. But 21.2% responses are average and the remaining 5.9% respondents are providing dissatisfactory responses.

So, from of this survey question, it is become clear that students are not fully satisfied with the coverage of syllabus in class by the teachers. Hence, teachers should be more punctual for the completion of syllabus in class.

4. Teachers' communication skill

87 responses




Out of 95 respondents, 87 students give their responses regarding the teachers' communication skill.

86 responses




Out of 95 respondents, 86 students give their responses regarding the flexibility of student's classroom interaction.

86 responses




Out of 95 respondents, 86 students give their responses regarding the Career Counselling by institution.

86 responses




Out of 95 respondents, 86 students give their responses regarding the availability of faculty after class.

86 responses




Out of 95 respondents, 86 students give their responses regarding the satisfaction with internal assessment marks.

9. Regularity of feedback by teachers after internal evaluation




Out of 95 respondents, 86 students give their responses regarding the regular feedback by teachers after internal evaluation.

85 responses




Out of 95 respondents, 85 students give their responses regarding the availability of learning resources in library.

86 responses




Out of 95 respondents, 86 students give their responses regarding the Office Staff communication style.
